Programme Admission Precondition	<p>Student of the program can become anyone with bachelor degree/diploma - grade at least 75 (out of 100) or 3 (out of 4) - gained from the following directions: Turkish Philology, Turkology Studies, Turkish Studies, Modern Turkic Dialects and Literature, School Mastering Program with the concentration of Turkish language and literature, Department of Turkish Teaching, Department Turkish Language and Literature, Department of Social Studies' Teaching.</p> <p>Both local and international candidates have to pass internal field examination (passing grade in the exam is 61) at University, examination is held by the Institute of Post Graduate (IPS). As for language case, those candidates graduated from educational programs mentioned above during the last three years with the Turkish language as an instruction language are free from Turkish placement exam which is given by School of Languages at IBSU, in case candidate has Turkish language certificate corresponding to B2 level received last 3 years, is free from the Turkish placement exam, while the candidates graduated from above mentioned departments any time with the any language as instruction language, have to have either Turkish language certificate corresponding B2 or take Turkish placement exam at IBSU.</p> <p>Those candidate graduated from different above mentioned directions can become a student (in case they meet language requirements) in the program on condition after taking the additional courses assigned by the Faculty (Field) Board.</p>
Purpose of the Programme	Main goals of the program is to prepare the field (Turkish Philology) experts who will possess theoretical and practical knowledge, be able to use modern methods in research, communicating with the same as well as other fields' experts, conducting critical analysis and finding innovative solutions, open to new ideas and meeting the demands of the modern day academic realm.

<p>Student Knowledge Evaluation System</p>	<p>The goal of evaluation is to determine student’s education results qualitatively in relation to academic program goals and parameters.</p> <p>Student may be assessed orally and/or in a written way. A student’s knowledge and skills are assessed through 100 points grading system. It consists of midterm and final evaluations, sum of which makes up 100 points.</p> <p>Grading system allows:</p> <p>five types of positive grades:</p> <p>(A) Excellent – 91-100 points of assessment;</p> <p>(B) Very good – 81-90 points of maximal assessment;</p> <p>(C) Good - 71-80 points of maximal assessment;</p> <p>(D) Satisfactory - 61-70 points of maximal assessment;</p> <p>(E) Enough - 51-60 points of maximal assessment;</p> <p>two types of negative grades:</p> <p>(FX) Fail – 41-50 points of maximal assessment, meaning that a student requires some more work before passing and is given a chance to sit an additional examination after independent work;</p>



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	<p>(F) Fail – 40 points and less of maximal assessment, meaning that the work of a student isn't acceptable and he/she has to study the subject anew.</p> <p>For the midterm and final evaluations minimal passing grade is set. The final evaluation minimal passing grade must not exceed 60% of final evaluation grade.</p> <p>Midterm and final evaluation grade distribution, their minimal competence levels and assessment criteria are described in the corresponding syllabus.</p> <p>A credit can be awarded only after the attainment of learning outcomes, envisaged by the course syllabus and following requirements:</p> <p>Obtaining minimal competence levels set for midterm and final evaluations;</p> <p>Obtaining minimum 51 points out of 100 points of final grade.</p> <p>A student is allowed to take an additional (make-up) exam in case he/she scored 41-50 points of final grade or minimum 51 points, but did not obtain minimal competence level set for final evaluation.</p>
<p>Field of Employment</p>	<p>Graduates might be occupied as a research assistant and study proses administrator, also the can continue their doctoral education at the Turkish Philology departments. They can work as a field expert at private and public research institutes; besides graduates can work as a language editor in Turkish electronic platforms like journals, webpages, newspapers and also they can get job at the private and public archives, libraries, related sectors; also the can get job as a language and field expert at the governmental organization like the Embassies of Turkey abroad etc.</p> <p>Graduates can work in the departments of Turkish Philology in the Turkic Republics , like Azerbaijan, Turkmenistan etc. as a research assistant and continue their doctorate educations in the mentioned republics. Also they can work both in private and public research centers as a field expert.</p>
